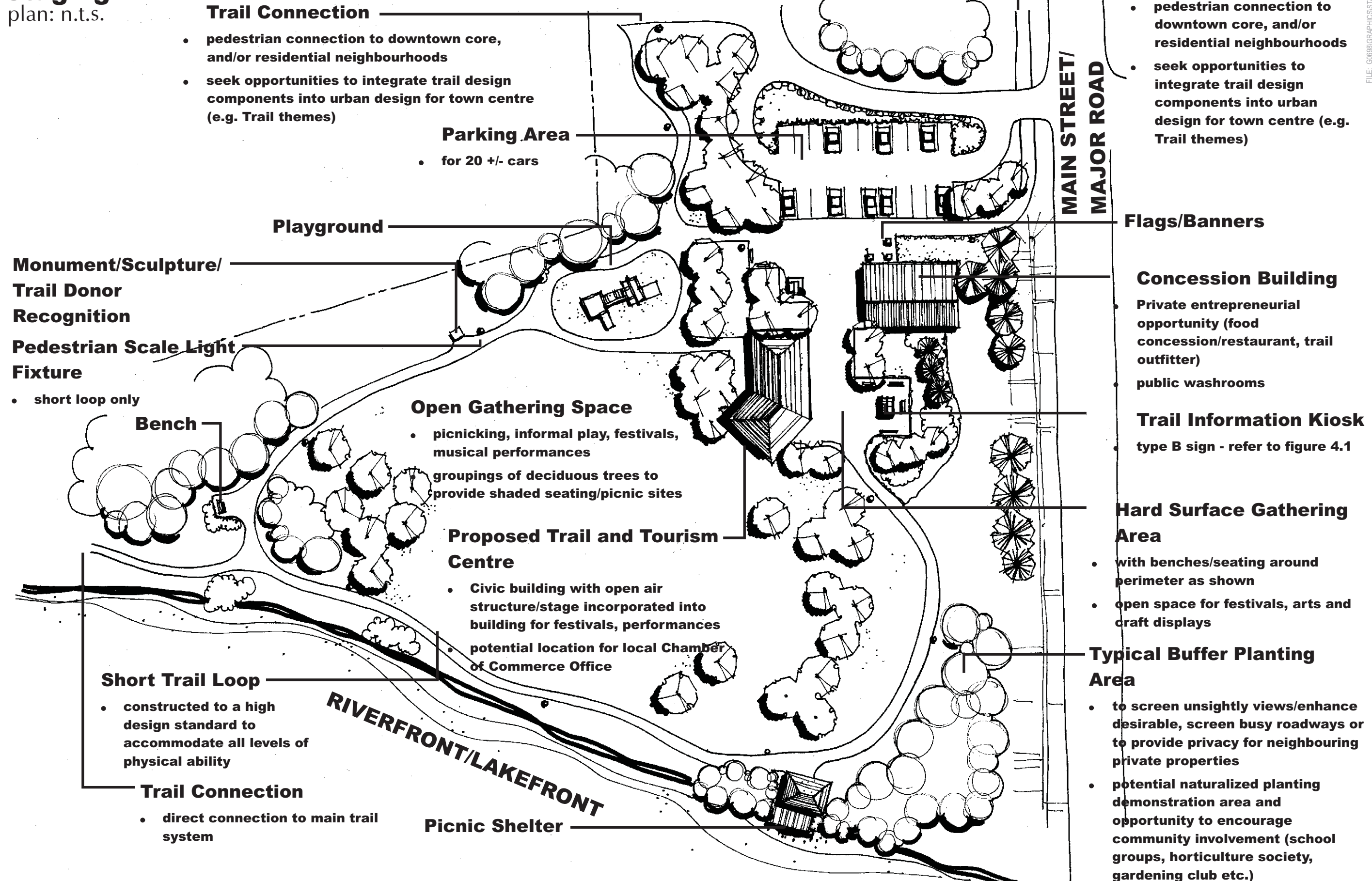


Typical Town Centre /Urban Staging Area

Trail Connection

- pedestrian connection to downtown core, and/or residential neighbourhoods
- seek opportunities to integrate trail design components into urban design for town centre (e.g. Trail themes)

Parking Area

- for 20 +/- cars

Pedestrian Scale Light Fixture

- short loop only

Bench

Open Gathering Space

- picnicking, informal play, festivals, musical performances
- groupings of deciduous trees to provide shaded seating/picnic sites

Proposed Trail and Tourism Centre

- Civic building with open air structure/stage incorporated into building for festivals, performances
- potential location for local Chamber of Commerce Office

Short Trail Loop

- constructed to a high design standard to accommodate all levels of physical ability

Trail Connection

- direct connection to main trail system

Trail Connection

Flags/Banners

Concession Building

- Private entrepreneurial opportunity (food concession/restaurant, trail outfitter)
- public washrooms

Trail Information Kiosk

- type B sign - refer to figure 4.1

Hard Surface Gathering Area

- with benches/seating around perimeter as shown
- open space for festivals, arts and craft displays

Typical Buffer Planting Area

- to screen unsightly views/enhance desirable, screen busy roadways or to provide privacy for neighbouring private properties
- potential naturalized planting demonstration area and opportunity to encourage community involvement (school groups, horticulture society, gardening club etc.)
