

Tips & Tricks

1. Check the **weather!** Hikes do run rain or shine therefore please dress appropriately for whatever Mother Nature has planned.
2. Have a look at the Hike Haliburton Festival, **Google Map** at www.trailsandtours.com to navigate from hike to hike.
3. **Register Online** before October 1st, 2008 and receive a free festival t-shirt. (t-shirts will be distributed at the Family Blast Off BBQ & Blister Ball)
4. Visit the Hike Haliburton Webpage & Facebook Group regularly for updates, revisions and Hike Haliburton Festival News.
5. Use the county map pages 14 & 15 to navigate from hike to hike.
6. Make sure to know the number of your hike(s) and follow the corresponding Hike Haliburton Festival Signage to your hike(s).
7. Enter our **Photo Contest!!** For contest details go to page 25 & 26.
8. And most importantly call all your friends and invite them out to this year's Hike Haliburton Festival!!!

What to Bring?

- Day Pack, which should include
 - Water
 - Snacks
 - Rain Jacket & Warm Clothes

- Hike Attire
 - Comfortable/sturdy footwear (hiking shoes/boots recommended)

- Please remember to bring treats, leash, water dish, water & "Poop Bags" for your K-9 friends.
